Peer Support Specialists and Recovery Mentors are people with lived experience of recovery from a substance use disorder, mental health condition, or both. They provide support to others experiencing similar challenges. Peers are trained and certified by the Oregon Health Authority to help our clients identify and achieve their personal recovery goals.

What We Offer

Peers work with you to build self-help skills and provide coaching about available community supports and services, including:

- Help you prepare and plan for appointments
- Share problem-solving skills
- Help access health and social service resources
- Assist with housing applications
- Help with resume writing
- Assist with parole and probation
- Communication with agency staff and case managers at various organizations
- Help obtain clothing through vouchers and community organizations

Help With Rides To:

- Recovery meetings
- Job searches
- Interviews
- Bus passes
- Getting a photo ID
- Going back to school
- Food boxes
